

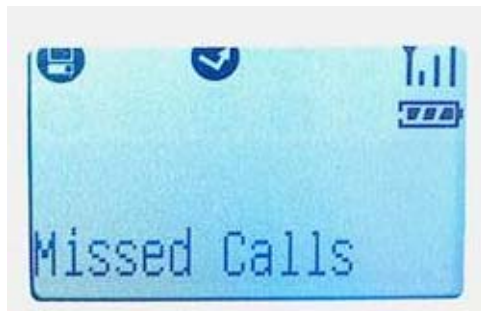
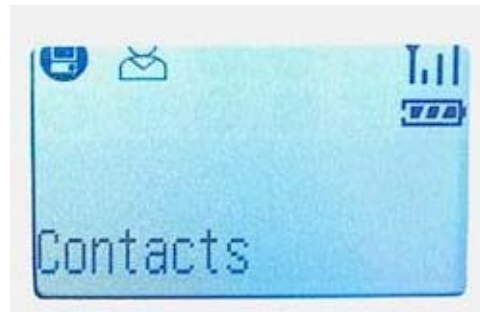
How to use

Installing Skype is very easy, you download the executable installer file from www.skype.com and when running it the first time it will ask you to create a Skype account. When you're done with that, you install the included driver CD, plug in the USB dongle and turn the phone on. Skype directly asks you whether or not you want to use the phone with Skype. When you accept the phone will show your account name and is ready to use. You don't need to connect the phone because it connects automatically with the included dongle. And you've got a wide range of language you can select from.



Display features

The display integrated on the phone is able to show the information you want it to. And it even has its own little operating system which allows you to setup your phone at wish. You've got five ringtones you can choose from; you can check your missed calls, check upon your last calls and view your contact list. When you want to call with the phone you can easily look in to your contact list or in your "recently called" list without checking your computer. Or you can just dial a number you want, Skype will perform the call, while all you've got to do is operate the phone like every other phone.



Every day use

The Skype phone can be used everywhere you want it to. Mine is always connected and I walk around the office with it. When I'm too far away from my PC it will result in a loss of sound quality, but the display always shows the connection strength. The battery life is better than expected. I can walk around the entire day without recharging and the best of all, I've got so many hours of talking time.
